5. If you don't like the sequence that you've placed things, rearrange the boxes until you like the order.

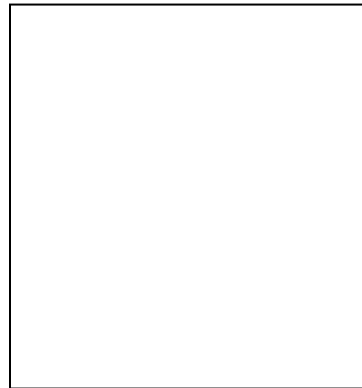
